**“TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SALE OF THE CONDEMNED  
FIRE VEHICLES& PUMPS BY SEALED TENDERS.”**

1. The Intending Tenderers can inspect the condemned Fire Appliances / Pumps at the concerned Fire Station premises during the Office hours on all days.
2. The intending Tenderers should furnish Sealed Tender separately on each condemned un-serviceable Water Tender / DCP Water Tenders / Trailer Pump / Foam Tender and Portable Pump so as to reach the concerned District Headquarters Station Fire Officer one day earlier to the date of opening of the Sealed Tenders duly enclosing Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousands only) for each condemned Water Tender / DCP Water Tenders and Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two thousands only) for each Trailer Pump / Foam Tender and Portable Pump, through Bank Draft drawn in favour of “ District Disaster Response and Fire Officer of the concerned District”.
3. The Tenderers should furnish the Sealed Tenders separately for each condemned Water Tender / DCP Water Tenders / Trailer Pump / Foam Tender and Portable Pump with E.M.D. of Rs. 10,000/- and Rs. 2,000/- as each case may be.
4. The Tenderers who submitted Sealed Tenders with E.M.D. by Demand Draft for each Vehicle and Pump one day before the date of opening of Sealed Tenders are only eligible to participate at the time opening of the Sealed Tenders.
5. Those Tenderers who furnish the Tender(s) without E.M.D. for condemned Fire Vehicle / Pump, their sealed Tenders will not be considered.
6. The Tenderers should submit the following particulars on a separate paper along with the Earnest Money Deposits (E.M.D.) in respect of each condemned Fire Vehicle / Pump.

7. On the top of the Sealed Tender cover it must written as follows:

**“SEALED TENDER FOR THE PURCHASE OF CONDEMNED VEHICLE / PUMP  
No \_\_\_\_\_, KEPT AT FIRE STATION \_\_\_\_\_.”**

8. All Tenderers should be present at the place of opening of Sealed Tenders on the scheduled Date and Time well in advance at the time of opening of Sealed Tenders, failing which the Sealed Tender of the absentee will not be opened.

9. The successful Tenderer should pay 25% of the Tender amount for each vehicle and pump in addition to the E.M.D. and obtain receipt for the amount paid immediately after the Sealed Tenders are opened. Otherwise such Tenderer shall forfeit the Earnest Money Deposited by him.

10. The E.M.D. will be refunded to the unsuccessful Tenderers after completion of the opening of Sealed Tenders.

11. The Tendered amount realized above the upset price fixed shall be confirmed at the same day after opening of the Sealed Tenders. The highest Tenderer should have to deposit full amount (or) 25% of Tendered amount on the same day and required to take delivery of the vehicle \_\_\_\_\_ in the same day (OR) within 10 days by paying remaining balance with G.S.T. (18%) and TDS (1%) and etc.

12. The Tendered amount realized less than upset price fixed is subject to the approval of the Director General of State Disaster Response & Fire Services, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada, Krishna District.

13. The successful Tenderer shall remit the remaining 75% of the accepted tendered amount together with G.S.T. (18%) and TDS (1%) as applicable on the Sales Tax and take the delivery \_\_\_\_\_ of the Vehicle within 10 days on receipt of the Confirmation Orders of the Regional Fire Officer otherwise he / they will forfeit the amount collected from him/them earlier.

14. If the highest Tendered amount is less than upset price fixed is not accepted by the Director General of State Disaster Response and Fire Services, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada, Krishna District, the amount paid will be returned to such Tenderer on production of Official Receipt and such Vehicles will not be delivered to such Tenderer.

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15. Any loss incurred by the Government due to re-sale of such Fire Appliances/Pumps by Sealed Tenders, the same will be recovered from the Defaulters under Revenue Recoveries Act.

16. For the loss sustained to the Fire Appliances / Pumps from the date of Sale by Sealed Tenders to the date of delivery, the Department will not be responsible. The delivery of the Vehicle / Pump should be taken on the own cost of the successful Tenderer.

17. The Department has got every right to change or add any other conditions before opening of the Sealed Tenders.
