ORDER:

In the reference first read above, Government have fixed the rates of standby and pumping charges undertaken up by the A.P. State Disaster Response and Fire Services Department.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Director General, A.P. State Disaster Response and Fire Services, Hyderabad, has submitted proposals for revision of scales of charges for private pumping work and standby duties undertaken up by A.P. State Disaster Response and Fire Services Department, keeping in view of the prevailing cost of Fire Appliances, equipments, construction of Fire Station Buildings and also salary of manpower which has gone up considerably from year to year.

3. The Government after careful consideration, hereby accept the proposal of the Director General, A.P. State Disaster Response and Fire Services, Hyderabad, and accord sanction permitting him to of revise the hire charges for standby duties and private pumping work etc. taken up by the A.P. State Disaster Response & Fire Services Department, at the rates shown in the Annexure to this order.

4. The rates as revised herein shall come into effect immediately.

NOTE

- (i) In calculating the distance for the levy of charges at the rates prescribed in column (2) the total distance covered by the Vehicles from time it leaves Fire Station till it returns to the Fire Station after rendering service, should be taken into account.
- (ii) Only the actual period of time for which the pump of the Fire appliance actually worked should be taken into account for levying the charges at the rates prescribed in column (3) and this is in addition, standby charges collected, if any pumping work is done, in connection with standby.
- (iii) To arrive at the period of detention or standby of the vehicle for which the charges are to be levied at the rates prescribed in column (4) the time taken for journeys and the period for which the pump was worked for which separate charges are levied as prescribed in column (2) and (3) respectively should be deducted from the total absence of the vehicle from the Fire Station concerned for rendering the services.
- (iv) In calculating the charges recoverable for services rendered by Fire appliances, Ambulances the time spend in servicing the vehicles or in setting right defects if any in them shall be excluded.
